## **ESPAD** data collections

Europe's largest harmonised data collection on substance use

- 26 countries in 1995
- 30 countries in 1999
- 35 countries in 2003
- 35 countries in 2007 (plus 5 in 2008)
- 39 countries in 2011
- 35 countries in 2015
- 46 European countries have participated



### **ESPAD 2015**

- 35 European countries
- 96 043 students (15-16 years old)
- In the 6 waves of data collection (1995, 1999, 2003, 2007, 2011 and 2015) about 600 000 students have participated




## ESPAD 2015 package
